#### **ACCREDITED COURSES**

### **UJ STUDENTS**

### STEP 1: Submit an application

Submit a copy of your ID document and your UJ student number to Smangele Zwane at smangelez@uj.ac.za, and indicate which course you wish to study. You will receive a letter of acceptance.

### Step 2: Pay the course registration fee

## **STEP 1: Submit an application**

Submit a copy of your ID document plus a copy of your matric certificate to Smangele Zwane at smangelez@uj.ac.za, and indicate which course you wish to study. You will receive a letter of acceptance.

# Step 2: Obtain a UJ student number

Take your acceptance letter to the UJ Enrolment Centre, Auckland Park Kingsway Campus (APK), University of Johannesburg. After completing a manual application form, you will be provided with a UJ student number.

## Step 3: Pay the registration fee

Next, you need to pay R300 into the following account:
