## In-Person Credited Courses (For UJ Students)

---

The UJCI is proud to announce that the Basic Mandarin, Intermediate Mandarin, and Business Mandarin courses have been approved as year-long credited modules for the 2026 academic year at the University of Johannesburg.

### 1. Basic Mandarin (Qualification Code: S7011Q):

This course is designed for students with little or no Chinese language background. It aims to introduce students to the fundamentals of Mandarin language.

### 2. Intermediate Mandarin (Qualification Code: S7012Q):

This course is designed for students who have completed Basic Mandarin or have some prior knowledge of Chinese language and culture. The aim of this course is to introduce students to further fundamentals of Mandarin by engaging in the following aspects of the language: grammar learning, exercises of Chinese characters, and oral discourse in daily life situations.

### 3. Business Mandarin (Qualification Code: S7014Q):

Business Mandarin is designed for learners who wish to develop practical Chinese communication skills for professional contexts. The course introduces essential business vocabulary, workplace expressions, and cultural etiquette relevant to meetings, negotiations, presentations, and email communication. Through scenario-based learning and interactive activities, students gain confidence in using Mandarin for real business tasks and cross-cultural interactions.

This course is ideal for students preparing for careers involving Chinese companies, international trade, finance, management, and global communication.

### Step one: Apply for a student number and PIN/password.

- . Select 2026 as the academic year, and enter the token HUMSLP.
- . Select either Basic or Intermediate Mandarin, and complete the drop-down forms.
- . You will receive a student number and will be prompted to create a PIN/password.

### Step two: Apply for Registration

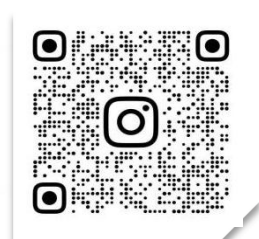
